


 An unlimited number of stoppages of work of 1 hours' duration which may be organised and/or arranged in single and/or consecutive periods.

In support of reaching an enterprise agreement with your employer, do you authorise the taking of the following protected industrial action, separately, concurrently and/or consecutively, in the form of:


An unlimited number of stoppages of work of 4 hours duration which may be organised or arranged in single and/or consecutive periods.

In support of reaching an enterprise agreement with your employer, do you authorise the taking of the following protected industrial action, separately, concurrently and/or consecutively, in the form of:


3. Taking a full 1-hour undisturbed meal break 3 times per day within the designated mealtimes being breakfast, lunch & dinner for an indefinite period.


4. An unlimited number of bans on mooring operations before 0700 hours and after 1730 hours.


5. An unlimited number of bans on unlashing cargo until after the vessel is secure alongside for an indefinite period.


6. An unlimited number of bans on preparing and providing meals for anyone other than the ship's crew for an indefinite period.
