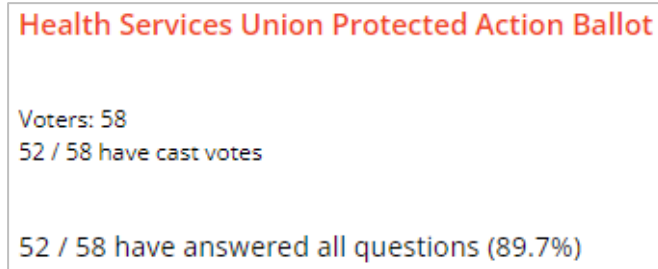
1. Ballot Result

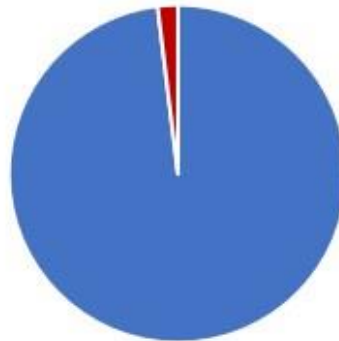
