The peak councils (the Australian Council of Trade Unions, the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry, the Australian Industry Group and the Council of Small Business Organisations Australia) and the Commonwealth may file submissions in relation to the operation of ss 243 and 244 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) by **4:00 pm (AEST), Friday, 4 August 2023.**
- 3. The applicants and respondents are to file and serve any submissions in reply to the submissions filed pursuant to direction 2 by 4:00 pm (AEST), Friday, 11 August 2023.
- 4. The matter will be listed for hearing on **Thursday**, **17 and Friday**, **18 August 2023**.
