Fair Work Act 2009 cl.95, Schedule 1– FWC to vary certain modern awards

Variation of modern awards to include a delegates' rights term (AM2024/6)

Variation of modern awards to include a delegates' rights term for workplace delegates—Fair Work Legislation Amendment (Closing Loopholes) Act 2023 – commencing process to make a delegates' rights term –timetable confirmed.

Introduction

- [1] On 18 January 2024, I issued a <u>statement</u> commencing a process to vary all modern awards so that they include a delegates' rights term for workplace delegates by 30 June 2024. The process is required following the passage of the *Fair Work Legislation Amendment* (*Closing Loopholes*) *Act* 2023 (Cth) (Closing Loopholes Act) which received Royal Assent on 14 December 2023 and commenced operation from 15 December 2023.
- [2] The 18 January 2024 statement included a draft timetable for the award variation process and interested parties were invited to comment on the draft. One response was received from the <u>Australian Industry Group</u> (Ai Group). The Ai Group proposed an extension to the dates for filing submissions in reply and submissions in response to draft award terms. It also proposed a change in the dates for consultation.
- [3] In preparing the draft timetable, I considered the <u>draft timetable for the Annual Wage</u> Review 2023-34 and the <u>timetable for the Modern Awards Review 2023-24</u>. I also noted that the Commission is required by the Closing Loopholes Act amendments to make determinations varying modern awards by 30 June 2024. In these circumstances, I am unable to accommodate Ai Group's request to vary the draft timetable.
- [4] The final timetable is set out below:
