

Hospitality and Retail Trade industries

Industry risk

For the period from 1 January 2020 to 30 November 2020, the FWO resolved 3,494 requests for assistance involving a workplace dispute relating to the Accommodation and Food Services and Retail Trade industry divisions. While the FWO does not make a formal determination of compliance in all workplace disputes, a proxy for non-compliance can be derived by using the outcomes of the matter, that is whether it resulted in a monetary recovery or the use of a statutory enforcement tool. Using this derived approach, Accommodation and Food Services had the highest industry non-compliance rate of 29%, while Retail Trade was third with 28%. The average for all industries was 26%.

Focussing on industry sub-sectors (ANZSIC groups), two within these industries, Supermarket and Grocery Stores and Specialised Food Retailing, recorded a non-compliance rate within the Top 10 (40% and 34%, respectively). A further five sub-sectors recorded an above average non-compliance rate.

The Regulatory Compliance Risk Model², developed by the FWO's Strategic Analysis team in 2019, further informs our understanding of industry risk. This model identified the Cafes, Restaurants and Takeaway Food Services and Fuel Retailing sectors as high risk.

Contraventions alleged for the Accommodation and Food Services and Retail Trade industries

The most common alleged contraventions for the Accommodation and Food Services and Retail Trade industry divisions were Wages and Conditions (13%), Termination (11%) and Annual Leave (8%). Wages and Conditions and Termination were consistent as top contraventions for all 7 sub-sectors with high non-compliance (see Table 3).

Allegations relating to penalty rate contraventions

There are a number of contraventions involving penalty rates and overtime. The Accommodation and Food Services and Retail Trade industries were among the top 3 industries for the prevalence of these allegations. Alleged penalty rates and overtime contraventions accounted for 15% and 11% of total alleged contraventions (only exceeded by Public Administration and Safety (16%)).

For the Accommodation and Food Services and Retail Trade industries, the industry sectors with the greatest proportion of alleged contraventions involving penalty rates and/or overtime were:

- Supermarket and Grocery Stores: 22% of alleged contraventions
- Specialised Food Retailing: 17%
- Cafes, Restaurants and Takeaway Food Services: 16%
- Clubs (Hospitality): 16%
- Fuel Retailing: 14%

In addition, of the 30 contraventions recorded for Entitlements – Annualised salary across all industry divisions, 17 were from the Accommodation and Food Services industry. Of these 17, 13 were from the Cafes, Restaurants and Takeaway Food Services industry group.

Access to education and advice for Accommodation and Food Services and Retail Trade

For the period from 1 January to 30 November 2020, there were 20,107,204 website visits. The pages with the highest number of pageviews related to awards, pay and minimum wages. In addition, the website contains a number of assistance pages specific to the hospitality and retail industries (see Table 4).
