AM2014/190 - four yearly review of modern awards - transitional provisions - accident pay

We refer to the directions issued by Vice President Watson on 31 October 2016 for the filing of materials and submissions in these proceedings.

The CMIEG is currently preparing its materials in the proceedings. Due to the Christmas-New Year hiatus, we anticipate that we are not likely to be in a position to file our materials on 3 February 2017 in accordance with the current timetable.

By consent of the AiGroup, ABL, CFMEU and APESMA, the CMIEG, respectfully requests that the timetable for the matter be amended as follows:

1. The Coal Mining Industry Employer Group (CMIEG) to file written submissions and any witness statements or documentary material on which it seeks to rely, by 4.00pm on ~~3 February 2017~~ 24 February 2017.

2. Any party supporting the CMIEG's application, to file written submissions and any witness statements or documentary material on which the party seeks to rely, by 4.00pm on ~~17 February 2017~~ 3 March 2017.

3. Any party opposing the CMIEG's application, to file written submissions and any witness statements or documentary material on which the party seeks to rely, by 4.00pm on ~~24 May 2017~~ 9 June 2017.

4. The CMIEG and any other interested party supporting the CMIEG's application, to file written submissions and evidence in reply, by 4.00pm on 7 July 2017.

5. The matter will be listed for hearing commencing on 24 July 2017. The current estimate of the parties is that the hearing will take 3 to 5 days.

The proposed amendments would not require any adjustment to the hearing dates of the matter. The CMIEG, APESMA and CFMEU are content, however, if the Commission prefers, for the hearing dates to be adjusted.

We have copied this email to the responsible officers representing the AiGroup, ABL, APESMA, CFMEU and AMWU. We have corresponded with the AMWU concerning the proposed amendments to the timetable but have not received a response.
