(AM2014/196 & AM2014/197) Casual and Part-time Employment Timber Industry Award 2010 ('Timber Award') – Casual Conversion

I refer to the Decision of the Full Bench [2019] FWCFB 3064 published on 8 May 2019 ('the Decision').

The Decision relates to the current casual conversion clause contained in the Timber Award and the Full Bench's view regarding the proposed insertion of the model casual conversion term.

The CFMMEU – Manufacturing Division ('CFMMEU-MD') has a significant interest in the Timber Award and initially raised (in correspondence of 20 September 2018 and 26April 20189) the issue of a potential anomaly regarding its provision for casual conversion.

In the decision referred above, at paragraph [8] the Full Bench stated that any interested party wishing to make a submission should do so within 21 days of the date of decision i.e. by 29 May 2019.

Unfortunately, the CFMMEU-MD, despite its best efforts will not be in a position to file its submission by the COB today.

This is due to a combination of reasons, including the union only becoming aware of the decision late yesterday and current industrial staff shortages due to illness.

For the reasons outlined above we respectfully seek an extension to file our submission until **COB**, **Monday 3 June 2019**.
