Re: Higher Education Industry – Academic Staff - Award 2010 Review (AM2015/6)

We refer to the above proceedings and to the hearings scheduled to occur on 12 and 13 December 2016 in Brisbane.

Bond University and the Bond University Academic Staff Association ('BUASA') have held discussions and have resolved the issues that were in dispute. BUASA no longer seeks the amendment to the Modern Award that it proposed.

Consequently, BUASA and Bond University ('the parties') no longer wish to be heard in relation to the four-yearly review into the *Higher Education Industry – Academic Staff – Award 2010*.

The parties respectfully request that the hearings scheduled for 12 and 13 December 2016 be de-listed and that the parties be excused from further participation in the proceedings.
