I refer to the publication by the Commission on 6 January 2017, of revised Exposure Drafts, Summary of Proposed Substantive Variations & Summary of Submissions – Technical & Drafting in the above listed matters.

In the short time I have had available to peruse the documents, it would appear the Summary of Proposed Substantive Variations takes little, or no account, of various submissions filed by a number of parties. In particular, I draw your attention to the submissions filed by United Voice and CCSA on 6 October and 30 September respectively in accordance with the Directions issued by the Commission and set out in [2016] FWC 6062. Those parties withdrew all or a number of applications to vary; however, the Summary of Proposed Substantive Variations – see in particular that concerning the Educational Services (Teachers) Award - still lists those parties as proposing a variation when, in fact, the variation is no longer being pursued and has been withdrawn.
