We thank the Commission for the opportunity to advise the Commission and parties of our position as follows:

Business SA notes the correspondence from AiGroup on behalf of the other interested parties dated 30 May 2017.

- Clause 7.2 Business SA submitted that the Facilitative provisions for flexible working practices Current cl.8.4 needs to be reproduced in ED. Business SA notes the AIG response and does not press this submission.
- Clause 13 Ordinary hours of work – in response to the Commission’s question, Business SA does not consider it necessary to impose an arbitrary cap.
- Clause 14.2 Business SA notes in transcript of 31 May 2017 that the APESMA submission has been withdrawn and does not press its response.
