- 2. Any party seeking to respond to an objection raised pursuant to point 1 above must provide such response in writing to <a href="mailto:chambers.catanzariti.vp@fwc.gov.au">chambers.catanzariti.vp@fwc.gov.au</a> by no later than 4pm on Friday 29 May 2020.
- 3. Submissions pursuant to 1 and 2 above shall also be sent to <a href="mailto:amod@fwc.gov.au">amod@fwc.gov.au</a> in both Word and PDF format.
- 4. After Friday 29 May 2020 the Full Bench will indicate its determination of the admissibility for the finalisation of this matter of any evidence the subject of an objection pursuant to point 1 above and will set a timeframe for provision by the parties of the names of any witnesses required for cross examination.
- 5. Once the list of witnesses required for cross examination is known, the matter will be listed for Hearing for the purpose of cross-examination.
- 6. By agreement of the parties, beyond the proceedings referred to in 5 above the decision will be made on the papers.

7. The parties are at liberty to apply to vary these directions.
