Pursuant to a decision of the Full Bench on 19 December 2019 in [2019] FWCFB 8538 concerning *Health Professionals and Support Services Award 2010* (Award), the Fair Work Commission (Commission) makes the following directions:

- 1. By no later than **4pm on Friday 28 February 2020**, any interested party is to file submissions, witness statements and other material upon which it seeks to rely in relation to the following matter:
 - Which Health Professional occupations should not be covered by the HPSS Award.
- 2. By no later than **4pm on Friday 27 March 2020**, any interested party is to file a response to the material filed pursuant to Point 1 of these Directions above, including any objection to the admission of evidence with reasons.
- 3. By no later than **4pm on Thursday 9 April 2020**, any interested party is to file a reply to the submissions filed in accordance with Point 2 of the above Directions, including any reply to any objection to the admission of evidence, with reasons.
- 4. All submissions shall be sent to <u>chambers.catanzariti.vp@fwc.gov.au</u> and <u>amod@fwc.gov.au</u> in both Word and PDF format.
- 5. The matter is listed for mention on **Tuesday 28 January 2020 at 10.00am (AEDT)** by telephone.
- 6. The matter is provisionally listed for hearing on **Monday 4 May 2020 Friday 8 May 2020** at the Fair Work Commission in Sydney.
- 7. Any party seeking to attend the hearing referred to in Point 6 above at a Fair Work Commission Registry other than the Sydney Registry shall make such a request via email to chambers.catanzariti.vp@fwc.gov.au.
